

Baby Bottle Boomerang – 2026

Bottle Collection Option

Overview & Instructions

Baby Bottle Boomerang raises awareness and financial support for **Safe Harbor Pregnancy Medical Center**. Church members receive specially marked baby bottles to fill with loose change, cash, or checks. Bottles stay in homes for about a month. After they are collected and deposited, Safe Harbor will notify your group of the total amount given.

Timeline

WEEK 1

- Distribute bottles to your members.
- Ask that bottles **not be marked** with stickers, names, or any other labels.
- Encourage participants to keep their bottles in a central place at home to remind them to give and to pray for Safe Harbor's ministry.

WEEKS 2–4

- Bottles remain in homes.
- Continue promoting the program with reminders.

WEEK 4

- Please remind participants to **return all bottles—filled or empty**—so we can reuse them next year.
- Collect all bottles at your meeting place.
- The liaison will gather, empty, and return empty bottles to Safe Harbor.
- Filled bottles are heavy—ensure you have help transporting them.
- Some people will forget; encourage late returns even if the bottles are empty.

Bottle Return and Bank Deposits

Steps for Coordinators

- **Empty all bottles** into a larger container (coffee can, bin, shoebox, ziplock bags, etc.).
Do NOT take any bottles to the bank - use any other containers that you can lift comfortably.
- As you empty bottles, **remove all foreign objects** (foreign coins, buttons, safety pins, tokens, etc.).
- **You do NOT need to count the money.**
- **Label each container** with your church name.
- **Remove all checks** from the bottles and **make copies of all checks** before going to the bank. This is essential so we can properly thank all donors. **PLEASE DO NOT FORGET THIS STEP!**
- Bring the **coins, cash, and checks** (in your labeled containers) to one of the two approved Renasant Bank branches.
- Our Renasant account is listed under: **Sav-A-Life of Northwest FL, dba Safe Harbor Pregnancy Medical Center**
- The bank will:
 - Count the money, prepare a deposit slip, and **give you a receipt**

Bottle Return:

- Return all of the following to Safe Harbor: **Bank receipt**, copies of all checks, all empty bottles
- When dropping these items off, please tell the volunteer or staff member **which church you are with**.
